**DEPARTMENT ORDER**

**SUBJECT: Guidelines on the Utilization of Fund Sub-allotment from the National TB Control Program to the selected DOH Hospitals.**

1. The Infectious Disease Office, NCDPC (IDO- NCDPC) shall sub-allot funds amounting to Eleven Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 11,500,000.00) classified as M.O.O.E. funds from the **National TB Control Program** allocated as follows:

1.1 The amount of Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P4,500,000.00) shall be used to augment budget for operations of the TB DOTS services in the hospital and other TB program-related and incidental expenses classified under MOOE accounts, allocated as follows:

<b>East Avenue Medical Center (EAMC)</b> .....	P 2,000,000.00
<b>Amang Rodriguez Memorial Medical Center(ARMMC)</b> ...	1,500,000.00
<b>National Children's Medical Center (NCH)</b> .....	1,000,000.00

1.2 For the conduct of trainings by Hospital TB DOTS team, the total amount of Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P4,500,000.00) is allocated as follows:

<b>East Avenue Medical Center as Demonstration Site for the Training on Hospital –DOT)</b> .....	P 2,000,000.00
<b>National Children's Hospital in support of their researches for TB in Children</b> .....	2,500,000.00

1.3 Additional amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,500,000.00) sub-allotted to **ARMMC**, shall be used to defray operational expenses in the conduct of research on TB-Diabetes Mellitus (TB-DM) Co-Morbidity. The use of funds shall allow ARMMC to engage other hospitals, agencies/organization both public and private that can perform quality assured culture services through their respective laboratories. This shall also cover the payment of agreed services rendered by PTSI relevant to their participation as participant in the conduct of TB-DM Study.

2. **The expected outputs** from these hospitals are as follows:

2.1 Reports on TB cases detected and treated;

2.2 As for demonstration sites, Technical Reports shall include post training activity undertaken by hospitals;

- 2.3 Reports on the TB-DM Study and Researches on Childhood TB shall also be provided to IDO-NCDPC) for future use and policy development.
3. The disbursement of funds shall follow government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
  4. The TB Coordinator shall ensure submission of fund utilization report certified correct by the accountant and endorsed by the Hospital Director to DOH Finance Service copy furnished NCDPC-National TB Control Program on or before the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the month.
