SUBJECT: Updated List of DOH-Designated HIV Treatment Hubs and Satellite Treatment Hubs

The Department of Health, through the National AIDS and STI Prevention and Control Program (NASPCP) under the Infectious Disease Office (IDO) of the Disease Prevention and Control Bureau (DPCB), continuously upholds its legal and moral mandate to ensure universal access to antiretroviral therapy (ART) to all people living with HIV (PLHIV) needing treatment.

Thus, antiretroviral drugs and other comprehensive HIV care services can already be accessed through the following DOH-Designated Treatment Hubs:



Likewise, the DOH continues to expand and decentralize the provision of primary HIV care services through the establishment of Satellite Treatment Hubs. This aims to increase access and maximize coverage by bringing the services closer to the key populations in key geographic areas, thereby ensuring linkage to care and providing primary care services including provision of ART to PLHIV early in the course of the disease.
