
The Philippine Academy of Pediatric Pulmonologists, Inc., Committee on Childhood Tuberculosis will hold its 2005 TB Awareness Program.

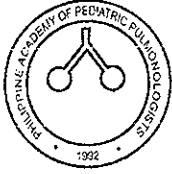

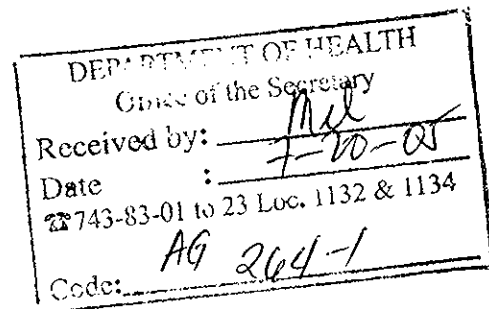


